#### 64991 Love's Messenger Waltz

(Messagero Amoroso) Chopin-Buzzi-Peccia 10-in. list price \$1.25

Here is the Chopin "minute-waltz," arranged for the voice with elaborate cunning, and sung by Amelita Galli-Curci. There have been little changes of course. It is sung brilliantly, joyously, triumphantly, bell notes tingling among the staccato flute tones of the voice. The record is sung in Italian.

John McCormack this month again enters the field of the popular song, with a ditty which will delight those who can appreciate the subtle perfection of his songs in Irish style. It is sung with just enough accent to give it piquancy, but with more than enough voice art to remind the hearer that the balladist and the interpreter of world music combine in the singer.

## FLONZALEY QUARTET

**74710 Quartet in A Major—Assai agitato**

Schumann 12-in. list price \$2.00

This impetuous movement from one of Schumann's too-little-known string quartets, might almost be an epitome of the composer's life—swift, stressful, hurried, yet with moments of lyric inspiration more tranquilly wonderful than silence itself. Considered as melody, harmony, rhythm, and the essentials of music, it belongs with the world's greatest. It is a flawless and superb record.

## MARTINELLI, GIOVANNI

**74712 Eugene Onegin—Air di Lenski**

(Faint Echo of My Youth) Tschaikowsky 12-in. list price \$2.00

Little is known in Canada of Tschaikowsky's romantic opera, "Eugene Onegin," but this remarkable melody, sung by *Lenski*, who is soon to be slain in a duel by his friend *Onegin*. *Lenski's* air is one that will reveal its subtler beauties to most persons after repeated hearings; all, however, will catch at once, something of the spirit of yearning that suffuses every note. There are some remarkable harmonic transformations of a theme about two-thirds of the way through the record. The final outcry a prolonged high tenor note, leaves the orchestra still weaving underneath.

## HEIFETZ, JASCHA

**74711 Serenade Melancolique** Tschaikowsky 12-in. list price \$2.00

This number will suit autumnal moods. Brief, self-answering minor phrases arise in deep, 'cello-like tones. Slow, labored yet mysterious rhythms arise, like prehistoric forms seen in vision against late sunlight over melancholy marshes. Every note speaks—the sombre expanse of the steppes, the intense and brooding spirit of the Russ. The record is for those who feel deeply.

## KREISLER, FRITZ

**64993 To Spring** Grieg 10-in. list price \$1.25

This lovely musical apostrophe to the Spring, one of the most beautiful of Grieg's shorter piano pieces, is arranged that Kreisler may play it for His Master's Voice Victor audiences. The violin plays it simply at first, with a broad, singing tone, gradually sweeping into its half-delirious ecstasy with prolonged, silvery notes.

## DE LUCA, GIUSEPPE

**64990 Mattinata** (Morning Song) Carducci-Fatuo 10-in. list price \$1.25

Mattinata—a song of morning, with the gold of the sun in one's eyes and the hopes of youth reviving within one's "manifest heart!" Celesta notes open it, then the voice is projected, in a kind of waltz rhythm, against an orchestral screen patterned over with harp tones. Beauty and inspiration fill this song.

## PHILADELPHIA ORCHESTRA

**74713 Symphonie Pathetique**—March-Scherzo

Tschaikowsky 12-in. list price \$2.00

Tschaikowsky in music is akin to Byron in literature—the same vibrating passion, the same strange extremes ranging from the finesse of the salon to barbaric primitiveness, the same restless wandering from land to land. Toward the end of his life he seems to have had a premonition of his death, and under its influence he wrote his "Symphonie Pathetique," a vivid expression of his revolt against the pain of life and the black abyss of death. The "March Scherzo" is one of his most inspired works—of irresistible rhythm, glowing harmonies, and titanic power.

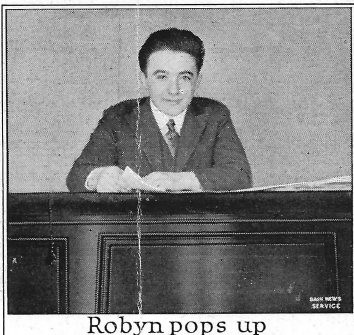
