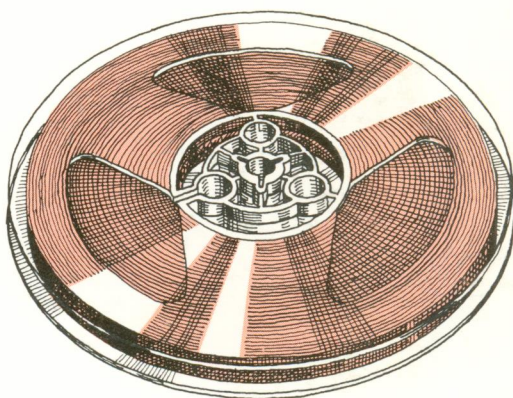

What is “Sound Plus Sound”?

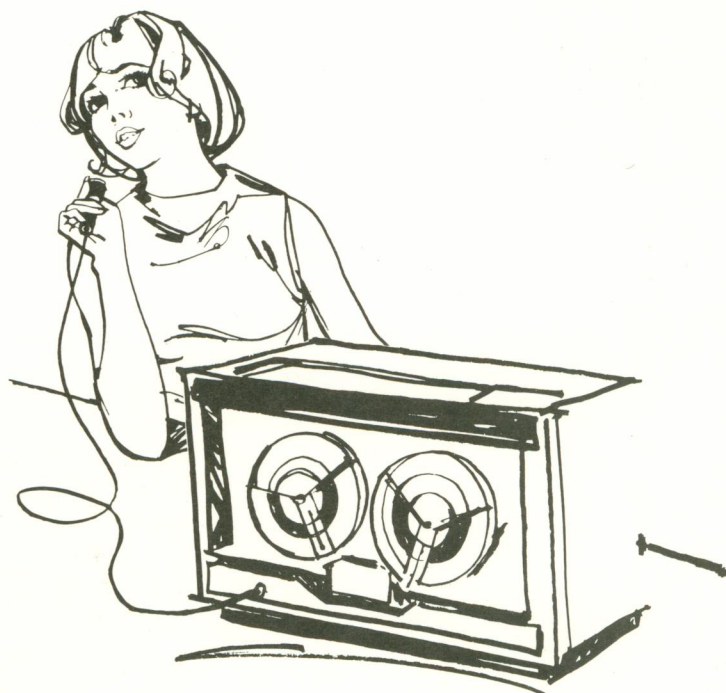


“Sound Plus Sound” is a tape recording feature available on some RCA reel-to-reel tape recorders by which you can listen to the sound from one track while you record on a second track at the same time. Then you can play both back together.

HOW DO YOU DO IT?

1. Make a master track

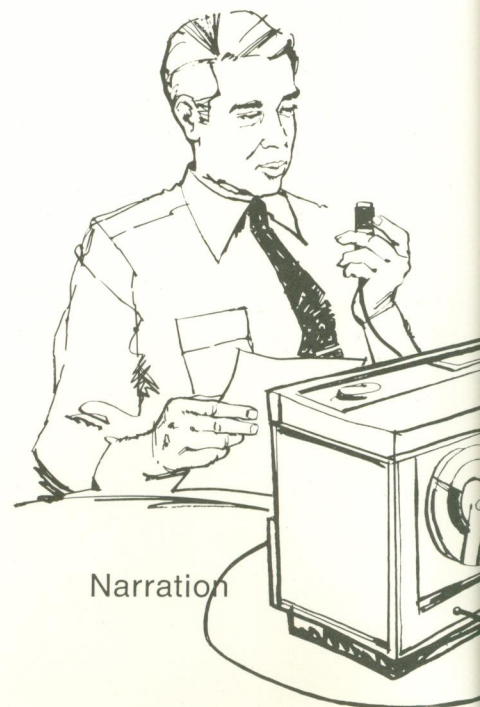
Plug microphone into Channel 2 "Mike" jack. While holding down the Channel 2 RECORD button, also depress the PLAY button. Now, record the MASTER TRACK. Then rewind, and you are ready to add the "Sound Plus Sound" track.

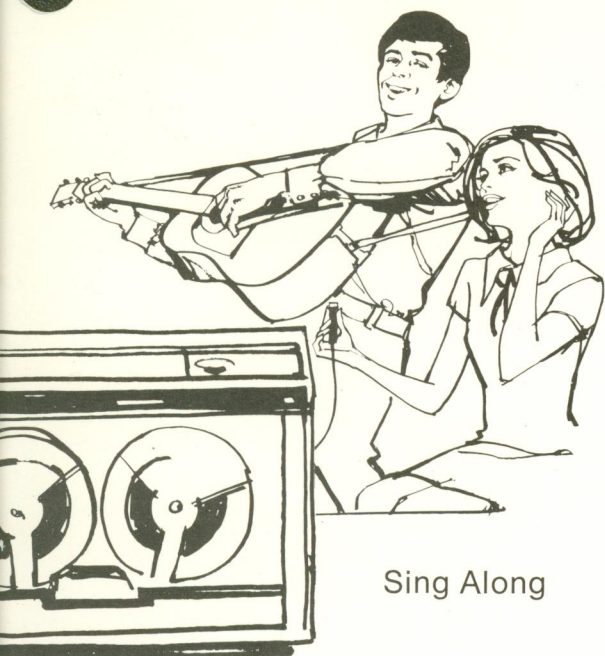
2. Make a "Sound Plus Sound" track

To record "Sound Plus Sound" track, plug microphone into Channel 1 "Mike" jack. While holding down the Channel 1 RECORD button, also depress the PLAY button. Now, listen to the MASTER TRACK and, at the same time, record on the second track.

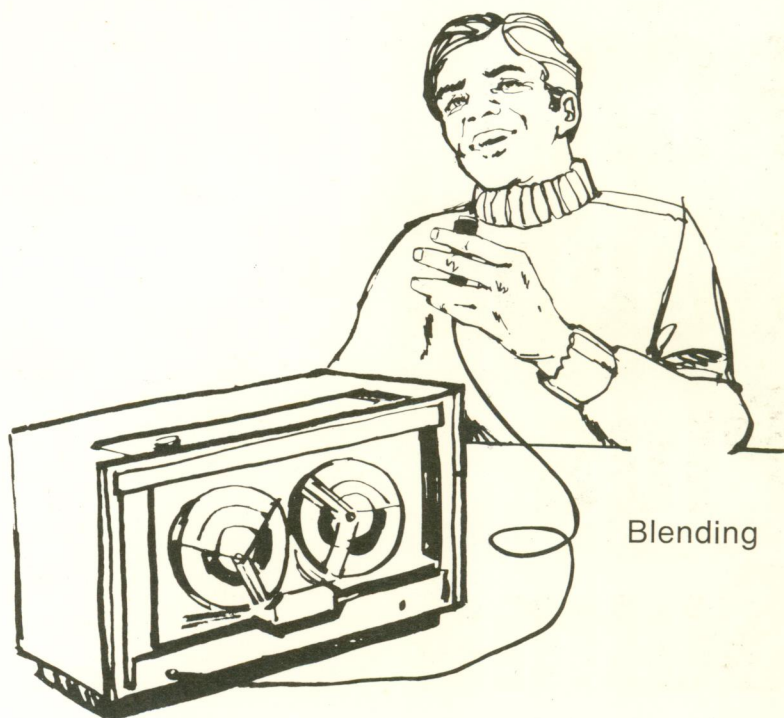
3. Play back both tracks

Next, you rewind and then play back both tracks simultaneously by adjusting volume and depressing PLAY button.

Blending

ITS MANY USES:

The uses of "Sound Plus Sound" are actually unlimited.

LANGUAGE LABORATORIES

This feature is used in Language Laboratories, where the teacher's voice is on the master track together with space for the student to answer back on the "Sound Plus Sound" track.

SING ALONG

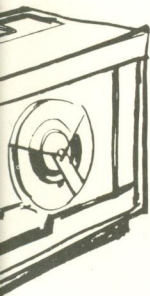
You can record music or a singing voice on the master track, then record yourself as the featured vocalist on the "Sound Plus Sound" track.

BLENDING

You can also record yourself on the master track, then record yourself blending in a different musical part on the "Sound Plus Sound" track. You can actually reproduce your voice as a duet.

NARRATION

You may want to record your own narration over a musical background. One example of this would be narrating slides from a vacation trip.
